Overall Job Objective: To work with staff leading the delivery of Music and the Performing Arts across the age and ability range. This will include mapping pupil progress for the area and identifying areas for development to inform school improvement.

Responsibilities

- To work with all colleagues developing learning and teaching opportunities in the subject
- To undertake a lead role in the establishment and monitoring of the delivery of the subject
- To work with other curriculum leaders when subject linkage is identified
- To monitor learning and teaching in Music and the Performing Arts throughout the school
- To take responsibility for school improvement planning in Music and the Performing Arts
- To ensure resource needs are identified for effective delivery and fall within budgetary restraints
- On a two year cycle, to co-ordinate departmental productions at Christmas (Yr1 Lower School, Yr 2 Upper School and Post 16)
- To co-ordinate the Leavers Assembly
- To provide an annual report to Governors on pupil progress and other developments in Music and the Performing Arts
- To undertake necessary and appropriate training
- To identify training needs of the staff relating to Music and the Performing Arts
- To maintain knowledge of developments in Music and the Performing Arts both locally and nationally forging links with centres of excellence e.g. Liverpool Philharmonic
