### Rationale

All of our pupils' progress is measured in E. Steps (Engagement Profile) and Steps (Progression). Some teachers may use other assessment tools (such as SCERTS) to enhance their assessments but will assess using Connecting Steps as their main form of assessment.

At the start of the academic year, all pupils are base-lined and assessed using B Squared (except for Post-16 who are completing external accreditation). This includes our Early Years pupils, as the Engagement Profile better suits the range of needs that our pupils have.

B Squared data and information from Pupil Progress Meetings continues to enable us to identify where pupils have exceeded expected progress and where pupils have not met expected levels of progress. There are breakdowns of interventions that have been implemented to support pupils, so that the impact of interventions can be measured more effectively. More detail about this can be found in the Assessment, Reviewing and Recording Policy for our school.
