There are a wide variety of pathways and courses available to young people and help is available to support them to make an informed decision. Whether or not they know what they would like to do it is advisable to find out about all of their options. Throughout your child's time in school, Career Connect will be supporting them in identifying their skills, qualities and interests to help support them in making well informed decisions about their futures.

Listed below are the main pathways available to young people post 16:

Career Connect will be working with students in a variety of ways, in order for us to get to know them and support them with the transition planning process.
